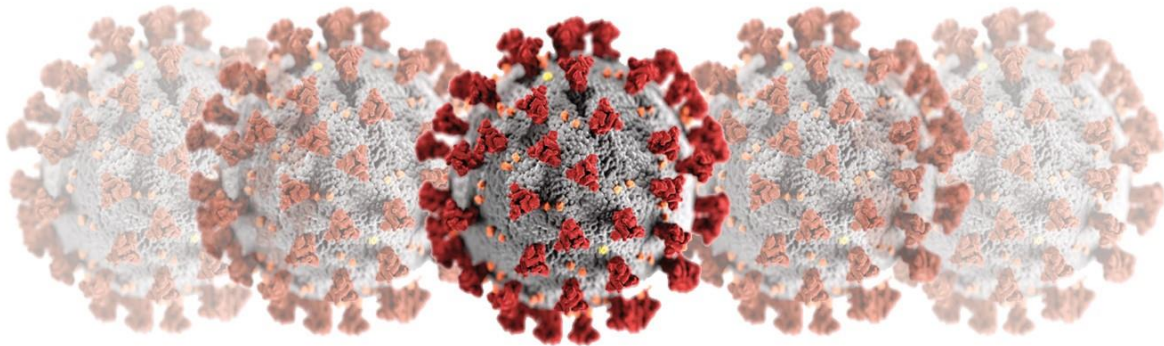

We will be processing glasses and contact lens orders as they arrive and will call you when they're ready to be dispensed. As we are at the mercy of our labs and contact lens distributors, please do not be alarmed if your order is delayed. We promise to do everything in our power to deliver your glasses and contact lenses as quickly as possible.

If you have glasses or contact lenses already needing to be picked-up, we're happy to ship them to you for a charge of \$15, or you can contact us to coordinate a time for you

to pick them up here. **WE WILL BE ACCESSIBLE DURING OUR CLOSURE!!!** If you've had a contact lens evaluation with us, stay tuned for an email from Dr. Contact Lens; a courtesy service that enables you to order your contacts online and have them direct shipped to you. We recommend having a 3-6 month supply of contact lenses and contact lens solution on-hand as we know not what to anticipate with regards to future distribution.
